CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) is a national volunteer organization supporting abused and neglected children.

ECM International is serving CASA with the implementation of design, construction, and initial occupancy of the \$1.6M Training Facility and Support Center. The 6,000 square foot office building will house approximately 15 CASA staff and contain a 48-seat training room. This facility is intended to be used for the next 20-30 years to train the court appointed volunteer child advocates that work to improve the lives of foster children.

ECM is providing full-service project management for its new headquarters in San Marcos. Working with the Board and staff, ECM developed a Master Budget and schedule; and an implementation strategy. ECM prepared all procurement documents, worked with CASA attorney, and assisted in the selection of designer and builder teams. ECM also led the procurement of all owner required services such as Geotech, survey, environmental, and worked with TxDOT and the COSM.
