ECM was hired to provide Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI) services for the 62/82 Marsha Sharp Widening project.

The Marsha Sharp Freeway is Lubbock's principal arterial, and primary east-west access road. It provides a western connection to West Loop 289, gives greater access Texas Tech University, downtown Lubbock and other high traffic areas and encourages development of the central business district.

The Marsha Sharp Widening project consisted of widening of the existing travel lanes and the addition of a 10' shoulder lane for approximately 0.50 miles and the addition of a 10' wide shoulder lane in both east and west bound lanes for approximately 5.50 miles using the existing center dirt median. When complete the Marsha Sharp Freeway will consist of three 12' wide lanes and two 10' wide shoulder
